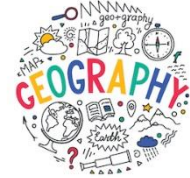





















Cultural Capital Geography
