The maximum number of governors permitted by our constitution is twelve.
Terms of office are four years for all governors, except the Headteacher, where a term of office is not required.

All governors are eligible to vote at meetings of the Full Governing Body. A governor is ineligible to vote on a matter related to a pecuniary interest.

The Governing Body has a flat structure; we do not have a committee structure as all items are the remit of the Full Governing Body.
