Key Learning

Maths-What's in a number? Exploring place value in 2-digit and 3-digit numbers; moving onto addition and subtraction; solving problems whilst reasoning and recording working out processes.

English-Reading: Asking questions to improve their understanding of a text. In **narratives**, creating settings, characters and plot. Being able to explore drafting and writing an increasing range of sentence structures.

Science-What do plants need to survive? What are the common parts of plants called?

Asking questions, planning and simple practical enquiries.

Other Learning

History/Geography- Where Am I? What do I know about my school? Exploring our Victorian School. Where is it and where did it come from?

RE- How easy is it to choose to do the right thing?

French- Why do we learn French? Classroom instructions and greetings.

Art- What are the main features of a successful sculpture? Focus on Andrew Goldsworthy.

Music- We will investigate 'In The Hall of the Mountain King' looking at composing our own rhythms.

Home Learning

Science- Observations of outside areas at home to use within discussions and observations made at school.

Using their learning from the term, the children will create a 3D model of a plant using a range of materials, label it and provide an instruction card about how to look after it.

Hook and Outcome

The children will be given a range of seeds and through questioning and exploration, they will develop an understanding of the journey a seed has. We have a school trip to Wisley Gardens - the children will explore first hand, through a workshop and walk, many aspects of plant life.
