



Key Learning

English: How do authors make me feel empathy for a character? Diary writing, a day on the farm.

Narrative: Write a chapter of the book from the point of view of a character in Charlotte's Web by E.B. White.

Maths: Multiplication and how it can be represented. Revisit 'What is a fraction?' Revisit differences between 2D and 3D shapes. Measurement focusing on volume, capacity and scales.

Science: What is a skeleton? What do skeletons protect? What can you find out by looking at the bones? How do skeletons support movement?



Other Learning

Art: What symmetry can we find in nature?

RE: What are the sacred places of worship?

Computing: Is word processing better than writing?

PE: Athletics and Football Rounders.

PSHE: Are relationships always positive? Recognising different types of relationships and how to maintain relationships. We will explore how to fix relationships and that not all relationships are positive.

Geography: Where on Earth is farming? What is Great Britain made of? Farming in different continents - is all farming the same?

Home Learning: Using the techniques used in art, draw an animal. It could be a farm animal, a pet or your favourite animal. Think about the symmetry you can see.
