Key Learning

English - Writing internal monologues for some key characters within a narrative. Using text as evidence and subject specific vocabulary. Writing an explanation text: instructions for mummification.

Maths - Geometry- Sort and classify 2d and 3d shapes and nets. What is the value of money? Looking at amounts, change and problem solving. Time: what's the difference between analogue and digital time?

Science- Rocks! Where do they come from? How are they made? What are they used for?

Other Learning

Computing - What is presentation media and how is it used? Exploring and using PowerPoint

DT - Can we make a moving information page from a book? Using knowledge of levers and linkages, and fixed and loose pivots.

French - What have we learnt in French this year? Revisit: number, days, months and greetings.

PE – How can we work as a collaborative team? How can movement tell a story using Egyptian music?

PSHE – How do I keep safe and stay safe?

History - How do we know about Ancient Egypt? What are the major achievements of the Ancient Egyptian civilisation?



Secrets of the Tomb



Home Learning

The children will be asked to research an area of interest within the Ancient Egyptians topic and create a replica artefact. For example, children might want to create a pyramid, an amulet or a tomb.

Hook

We will hook the children in by dressing as Ancient Egyptians and sharing a selection of sources about Ancient Egypt. They will then record the questions they have about them and the era, discussing how we can investigate the answers. The children will explore symbols and what they mean.

Outcome

PowerPoint presentation about the achievements of the Ancient Egyptians.
